## PARKLEA INMATES FURNISH THE PONDS

Inmates at the GEO operated Parklea Correctional Centre in Sydney have strongly supported an innovative project to enhance local community amenities.

They have designed and manufactured an extremely attractive array of community seating for the recreational areas of a new housing development in The Ponds, a new suburb in Sydney.

It is the result of a unique partnership between developers Landcom, Queensland artist Russell Anderson, West Sydney Institute of TAFE and The GEO Group Australia.

Anderson worked with the inmates over 18 months to design the furniture, which had to be robust, weather resistant and complement the local environment.

The furniture combines Aboriginal themes through a mosaic seating surface with a variety of designs for the main seat body.

Set at different heights to accommodate adults and children, the seats were manufactured at Parklea Correctional Centre's industrial workshops.

"We are delighted to have been able to play our part in supporting the local community, and in particular having the opportunity to encourage our inmates to put something positive back into the community," said the centre's offender services manager Allison Lang.

"Designing and manufacturing the seats gave the inmates the chance to gain fabrication skills accreditation that will support their search for work on release.

"It also gave them the experience of working with a renowned artist, meeting deadlines and working as a team."

Each inmate involved in the project has been formally and individually recognised with a letter of thanks from Landcom.
